### What is a Sports Rep?

As part of the University's ongoing commitment to student sport, the University has recently launched its Student Sport Board (SSB). The SSB is responsible for advising on, and having oversight across, the entire student sport and physical activity experience.

To support the SSB's work, we are seeking a student representative to present the voice and opinions of students within three key areas listed above. To help present this voice, they will be expected to work closely with SMSU to gather, and pass on student feedback, sharing this as appropriate with the SSB.

This is an exciting opportunity to work with key stakeholders to develop sport and physical activity opportunities for students at St Mary's, whilst also developing your own key employability skills.

- Attend all Student Sport Board meetings, providing updates on any relevant actions from previous meetings.
- Prepare for all Student Sport Board meetings by reviewing agendas and supporting documents.
- Develop strong relationships with students who you represent
- Support the Student Life President in leading Sport Forum three times a year.
- · Advise the Student Sport Board on all matters relating to the area you represent
- Gather and offer insight and feedback on the Sport St Mary's offer to help shape the future of sport & physical activity at St Mary's, in line with the Student Sport Board's aims, objectives and current projects.
- Act as an ambassador for sport & physical activity at St Mary's, encouraging all students to engage with relevant programmes.
- To complete any other duties appropriate to the role, as directed by the joint-Chairs of the SSB.
- To work closely with SMSU and communicate effectively with the Student Life President to ensure the student voice is heard.
